Mental Health *First Aid:*

working with people with mental health issues

What is Mental Health First Aid?

First Aid is the help given to an injured person before medical treatment can be obtained. Mental Health First Aid is the help given to someone developing a mental health problem or in a mental health crisis. The first aid is given until appropriate professional treatment is received or until the crisis resolves.

Why Mental Health First Aid training?

There are many reasons why people need MHFA:

- mental health problems are common
- there is stigma associated with mental health problems
- many people do not recognise mental health problems
- professional help is not always available
- many people do not know how to help

Course content

The course, broken into 4 x 3-hour modules, covers helping people in mental health crisis situations and/or in the early stages of mental health problems.

Crisis situations covered are:

- Suicidal behaviours
- Acute stress reaction
- Panic attacks
- Acute psychotic behaviour

Mental health problems covered are:

- Depression
- Anxiety disorders
- Schizophrenia
- Bipolar disorder

Participants will learn the signs & symptoms of these mental health problems, how to respond in crisis situations and where and how to get help. The course also helps to dispel some of the myths and stigma surrounding mental illness.

Who should attend?

This course will benefit all members of the community, and in particular - teachers, police, nurses, case managers, social welfare staff, support workers and employment agency staff, as well as business and local government employees.
